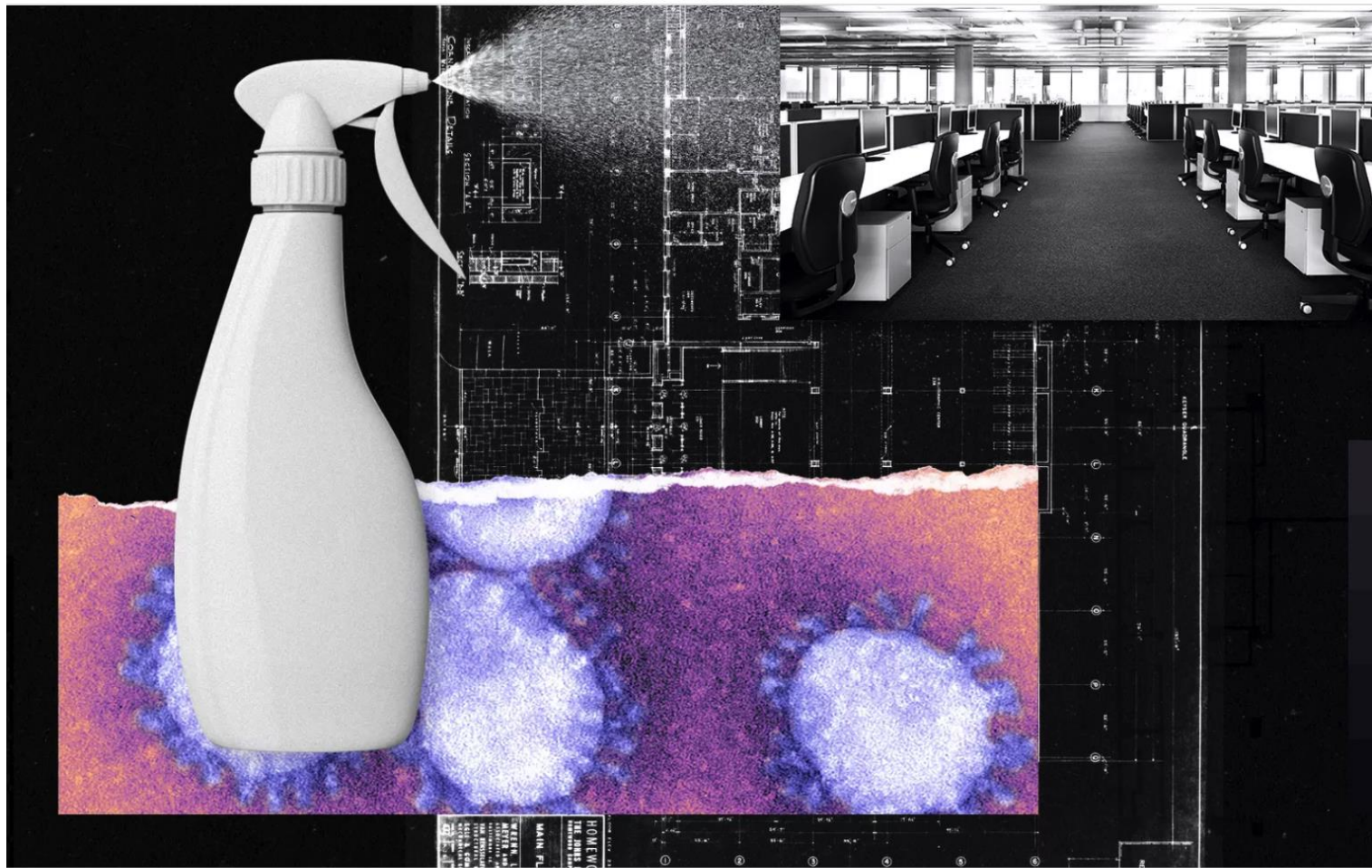

This is the end of the office as we know it

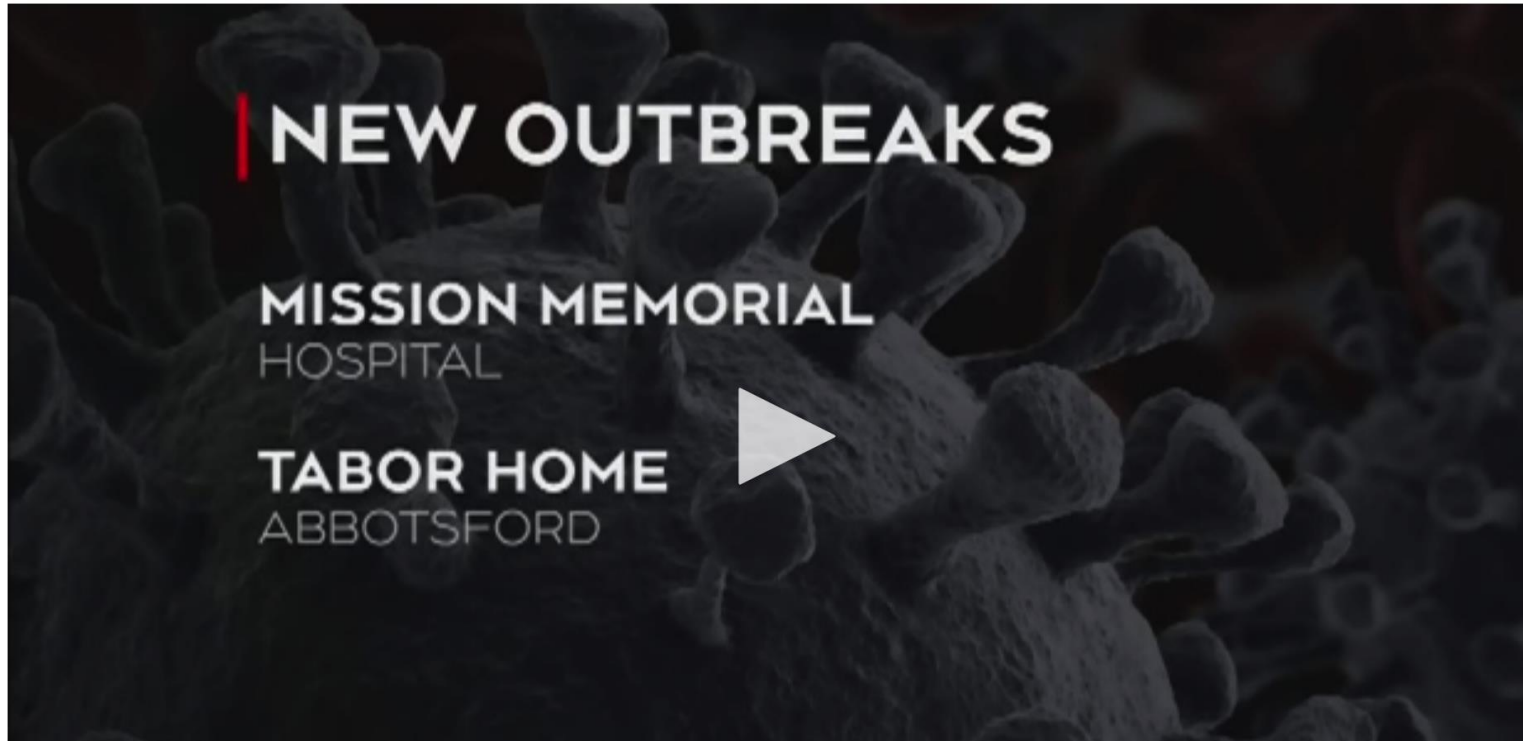
The pandemic already pushed millions to work from home. Many of them will likely go back to a very different office.
